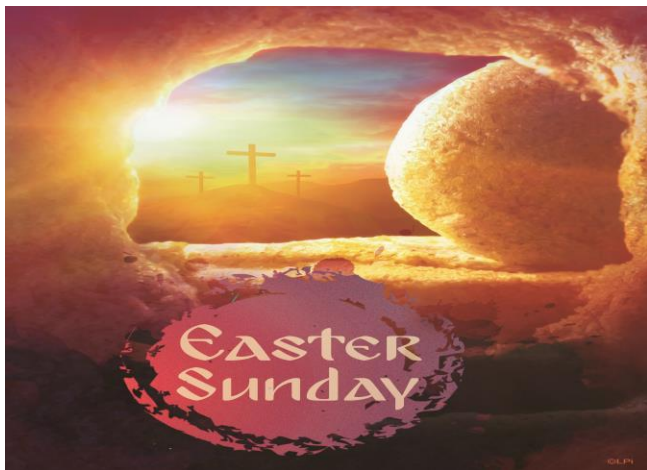

Penitents are encouraged to stand so they don't touch anything while getting up or down from kneeling (no kneeler or chair available). Please remember keep at least 6 feet apart for the confession line.

The Retreat House staff is disinfecting all surfaces each day and asks individuals not to attend if they are sick, have been exposed, or are at a high risk. There will be a full refund (or option to transfer to another retreat) if you are unable to attend a retreat.
