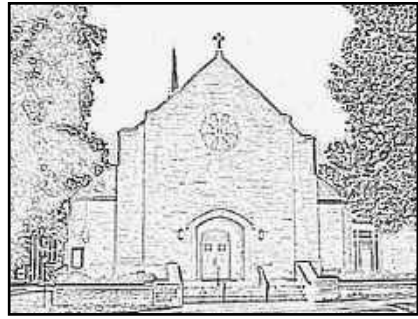

Parish Council Meeting Minutes – January 24, 2024

Call to order and Opening Prayer The Parish Council met in the Blessed Sacrament School Meeting Room on January 24, 2024, beginning at 6:30 p.m., moderated by Bob Svoboda, minutes taken by Clem Pella, covering for Justin Wemhoff, secretary.

Members present: Collin Aldrich, Ann Ames (Altar Society), Chris Beardslee, Ben Mattern, Aaron May, Fr. Morin, Mike Muff, Clem Pella, Bob Svoboda, Hai Tran, Jennifer Tran.

Members absent: Perry Demma, Fr. Froeschl, Justin Wemhoff.

Building & Grounds: The next meeting will be next week. On the agenda will be several projects, including snow guards for the church roof being one. Future projects will be compiled.

School: Current enrollment is 153. Jennifer has reached out to parishioners that will have children starting Pre-K or K in the fall to ask if they have considered Blessed Sacrament School. At this point, Kindergarten has 9 students slated to start in the fall. Pre-K has 17 or 18 students for this fall. The Dillon Grant has been submitted to assist with expenses for several projects.

Altar Society: The next fundraiser will be the Valentine's Day bake sale. They will be providing dessert items at some of the fish fry meals during Lent. On March 7th, they will host a meal for the Bishop and the Fathers before Confirmation. The next Praise and Worship night will be after Easter, with the date TBD. The Funeral Coordinator position is open.

Knights of Columbus: The fundraiser for the Women's Care Center was a success! There were many who viewed the Eucharist Miracles display with one viewer winning a door prize from KVSS. Thank you for your support! The next major project will be hosting fish fries. Please plan to attend on Fridays during Lent!

Finance Council: They are working on a preliminary budget hoping to keep the tuition rate the same. Health benefits are a large consideration as the costs have continued to increase in recent years. The crucial part of the campaign is over the next nine months as the final donations are needed.

Spiritual Liturgical: The mission will take place the evenings of Thursday, February 22nd and Friday, February 23rd. Fr. Zachary (SOLT) will be enlightening listeners about the devotion to Jesus in the Eucharist. Plan now to attend! The Christmas gift book distribution will continue next year. The location of the bookshelves in the west transept was discussed, to be brought to the next Council meeting. A subcommittee to select the purchase of a new processional cross was appointed. Fr. Morin brought forward concerns about funeral ministry.

Other Items: One request for alcohol to be served in our gym at a wedding reception, unanimously approved by the Council. No other items were brought forward. Next meeting: March 27th at 6:30 pm in the Meeting Room.

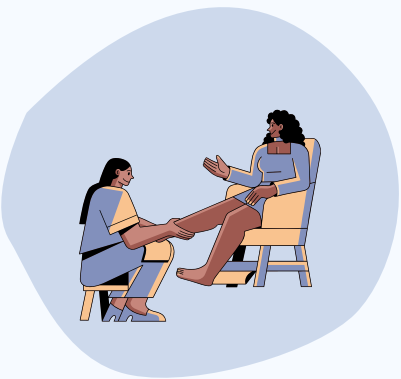
