

Forward is a ministry of Trinity Lutheran Church that provides diapers, wipes, and food for families in our community. Families receive 50 diapers or 30 pull-ups and a package of wipes per child per month. Families may choose up to 2 items of formula, cereal, or canned goods as available.

Families are also invited to Forward+ where they can both receive and donate clothing, toys, and household items.


