

Main Work

Blessed Sacrament began conducting its annual Charity & Stewardship Appeal campaign last weekend with follow up the weekend of May 11-12. The theme for this year is "For Such a Time as This" (Esther 4:14).

The Charity & Stewardship Appeal is the annual appeal of the Diocese of Lincoln which supports numerous apostolates such as Catholic Social Services, Newman Center, Villa Marie and Our Lady of Good Counsel Retreat House. It also supports diocesan offices such as the Office of Family Life & Discipleship and the Office of Hispanic Ministry.

Did You Know?

In 2023, 32% of Diocesan pledges were used to support the Diocese's offices and various programs. 68% of the 2023 pledges were returned to the participating parishes. This year's goal for Blessed Sacrament is to raise \$59,800 of which \$11,960 will support the diocesan projects. Any amount given to the Charity & Stewardship Appeal above the \$11,960 goal will remain at Blessed Sacrament.

"A wonderful result of the CSA is that it has a parish kickback. Not only does it help the diocese overall, but also our Blessed Sacrament parish!" says Matt Sestak who is directing the campaign this year. "Because of this, we have had so many parishioners not only maintain their donations but increase their commitment as well!!"

How can you be involved?

While all parishioners are asked to be involved by prayerfully considering their financial contributions, the time commitment needed to assist with the Charity & Stewardship Appeal is ideal for anyone looking to get more involved within the parish. "We spend about 15-20 minutes before and after each mass the first two weekends in May," says Matt.

Impact in our Parish and Community

"Helping with the Charity and Stewardship Appeal gives a sense of community as you are helping with the donations that contribute greatly to the various ministries within the Diocese." shared Matt. "Since starting to help this committee in May of 2023. I have


contributed more than just attending mass. It has allowed me to be more involved within the church community by simply giving a few hours in the springtime."

The amendment risks eliminating 50 years of common-sense protections for women and girls against unsafe abortion practices. After passing a similar constitutional amendment, Michigan quickly repealed informed consent laws, and state licensing and inspection requirements for abortion facilities.

GIVES ABORTIONISTS THE SOLE DISCRETION TO DECIDE VIABILITY

Women seeking an abortion don't see their OBGYN or family doctor. They go to abortion practitioners. This ballot initiative gives power to abortion practitioners, who may not even be licensed doctors, to decide whether a baby is "viable."

CREATES A RIGHT TO LATE-PREGNANCY ABORTION

Babies born as late as 32-36 weeks need machines to help them breathe. This is an "extraordinary medical measure" necessary for their life outside the womb. Under the ballot proposal language, these babies are not "viable" and may be aborted.

ARTICLE I, SECTION 31

OF THE NEBRASKA STATE CONSTITITION SHALL BE AMENDED TO READ...

"All persons shall have a fundamental right to abortion until fetal viability, or when needed to protect the life or health of the pregnant patient, without interference from the state or its political subdivisions.

Fetal viability means the point in pregnancy when, in the professional judgment of the patient's treating health care practitioner, there is a significant likelihood of the fetus' sustained survival outside the uterus without the application of extraordinary medical measures."
