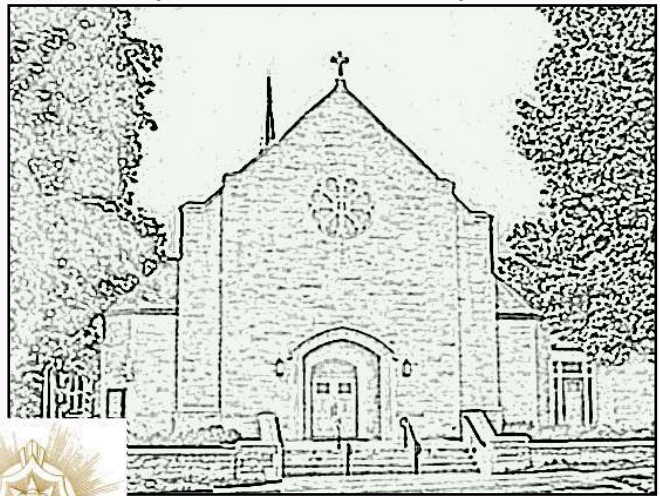

AUGUST 3-4 AND 10-11, 2024, CCD EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION WEEKENDS COMING SOON - CCD Fall Registration will be quickly approaching, and we invite parents to plan to take advantage of the Early Bird Registration weekend events scheduled Aug. 3rd-4th and Aug. 10th-11th. Registrations for CCD will be taken after the Saturday evening Mass, Aug. 3rd and Aug. 10th and before and after the Sunday Masses Aug. 4th and Aug. 11th.

During the CCD Early Bird Registration weekends, Parish tuition rates will be **\$35.00** for an individual child, **\$70.00** for two children or a family rate of **\$90.00**. These tuition rates will only be available during the CCD Early Bird Registration weekends. We will also honor these rates for registration turned in during the week of Aug. 3rd-7th. Parish tuition rates after the CCD Early Bird Registration weekends are **\$40.00** per child, or **\$100.00** per family.

Additionally, parents registering children for CCD will be asked to pay a **Diocesan Religious Education Fee of \$15.00, per student**, in addition to the Parish tuition fees. The Diocesan Religious Education Fee is being assessed to provide funding to support the administrative services, resources, and materials provided by the Diocesan Religious Education Office.

Completed registration forms with tuition fees can be turned in at the registration table during the registration weekends or dropped in the collection basket at any of the Masses or they can be mailed or dropped off directly to the rectory at: 1720 Lake St, Lincoln, NE 68502. **Please indicate "CCD" on the envelope. Please make checks payable to Blessed Sacrament Church.** Tuition assistance is available.

CCD tuition and Diocesan Religious Education fees can be paid using the parish Online Giving application. The link to the application is <https://giving.parishsoft.com/App/Giving/bsc>. Once you've logged in, use the **CCD Tuition** Fund option for exact CCD tuition fees due and the **Diocesan Education Fee** Fund option for exact DRE fees due.

Please note: If you choose to use the Online Giving application as your method of payment, we ask that exact fees due be paid for each Fund and not as installments over a period. Additionally, a completed registration form must be turned in at the rectory for processing purposes.

Copies of Baptismal certificates will be required at the time of registration for students enrolled in grades 1st, 2nd and 5th in the CCD program. If the student is new to CCD, outside of the above listed years, then we will need a Baptismal Certificate.
