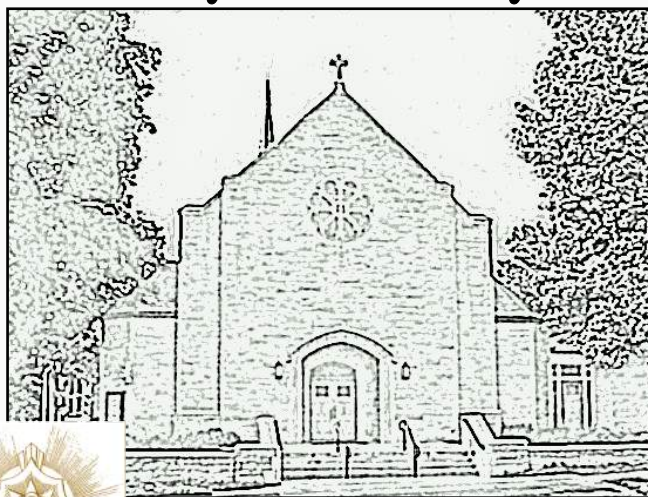

**AUGUST 10-11, 2024, CCD EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION WEEKEND** - CCD Fall Registration is here, and we invite parents to plan to take advantage of the Early Bird Registration Aug. 10<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>. Parish tuition rates will be **\$35.00** for an individual child, **\$70.00** for two children or a family rate of **\$90.00**. These tuition rates will only be available during the CCD Early Bird Registration weekends. Parish tuition rates after the CCD Early Bird Registration weekends are **\$40.00** per child, or **\$100.00** per family.

Additionally, parents registering children for CCD will be asked to pay a **Diocesan Religious Education Fee of \$15.00, per student**, in addition to the Parish tuition fees.
