

MARCH 5, 2025, ASH WEDNESDAY MASS – Join us on Wednesday, as we begin our Lenten journey together. Masses are at 6:30 a.m., 8:15 a.m., 5:30 p.m. & 7:00 p.m. Although it is not a Holy Day of Obligation, Ash Wednesday is a reminder of our mortality & sinfulness, & it prepares us for

LENTEN REGULATIONS FOR THE DIOCESE OF LINCOLN - Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of fast & abstinence. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence.

FASTING - means eating only one full meal with two smaller meals, which together do not equal the full meal. No snacks or eating between meals allowed. Fasting obliges all Catholics between the ages of 18-59.

ABSTINENCE - means eating no meat, nor soup, nor gravy made from meat. Abstinence obliges all Catholics over the age of 14.

SICKNESS, HARD MANUAL LABOR, PREGNANCY, ETC., automatically excuses a person from these obligations. Nevertheless, it should be pointed out that these are serious obligations. In cases of doubt or question, the priest who hears a person's confession should be consulted.

IDEAS FOR LENT ON SELF-DENIAL AND PENANCE - You could try some of the following:

- weekday Mass attendance, and/or Stations
- giving up television viewing, Facebook, Instagram, internet browsing, and/or using a smart phone
- participating in the CRS Rice Bowl
- say a daily family Rosary

a season of penance & prayer.

- do an hour for 40 days for Life and/or a holy hour at church
- daily Bible reading, and/or daily spiritual reading
- spend time in silence maybe on your drive to work or school, quiet time at a meal or a block of time throughout the day
- giving up smoking, alcoholic beverages, sweets, junk food and/or
- eating simpler meals and/or giving up one meal a day
- giving up anger, envy, grudges, and greed
- giving money to the poor or the church (with St. Vincent de Paul)
- being more cheerful, helpful, and respectful to family members, fellow workers, neighbors
- visit someone that is homebound
 - bear hardships, pains, sufferings, various kinds of discomforts and inconveniences with smiling acceptance and resignation






