



### Rides for the Elderly | Prison Ministry

March 2025

### Main Work

For many Catholics, attending Mass is a vital part of their faith journey—a time for worship, prayer and community. However, there are members of every parish who can't attend due to transportation barriers. Offering rides to those who cannot drive is not only an act of charity but a way to strengthen the parish and build a more inclusive and caring community.

Two groups at Blessed Sacrament provide transportation when needed: Rides for the Elderly and Prison Ministry. The circumstances are different, but the goal is the same: to give everyone the opportunity to receive the Eucharist, hear the Word of God and participate in communal worship. This act of kindness fosters a sense of belonging and ensures no one is left out due to logistical issues.

Blessed Sacrament's Prison Ministry provides transportation for individuals on work release at the Community Correction Center (CCC). These individuals present no danger to others and because Blessed Sacrament is the closest Catholic Church, that is the only place they

can attend Mass. They are picked up from CCC on West VanDorn Street, taken directly to church and back to CCC afterwards.

"I was able to take a gentleman to RCIA classes," shared Kathy Wells, who has been providing rides for over 15 years. When he joined the Church, she was his sponsor. "This work is very rewarding as people are trying to get their lives back on track and really appreciate the opportunity to attend Mass."

#### How can you be involved?

Offering a ride to someone in need is a simple yet powerful way to live out Christ's commandment to love our neighbors. By extending this kindness, we ensure all parishioners—regardless of their situation—can attend Mass.

Many people who cannot drive may feel isolated or disconnected from the Church. By offering them a ride, volunteers help these individuals maintain their connection to the Church.

Additionally, providing transportation encourages intergenerational bonds within the parish. Younger or more mobile members can develop friendships with elderly parishioners, learning from their wisdom and deep faith.

Beyond the walls of the church, acts of service like this inspire others to help their neighbors, fostering a culture of kindness and mutual support. A parish that actively assists those in need becomes a beacon of love and service in the larger community, demonstrating the Gospel's message in action.
