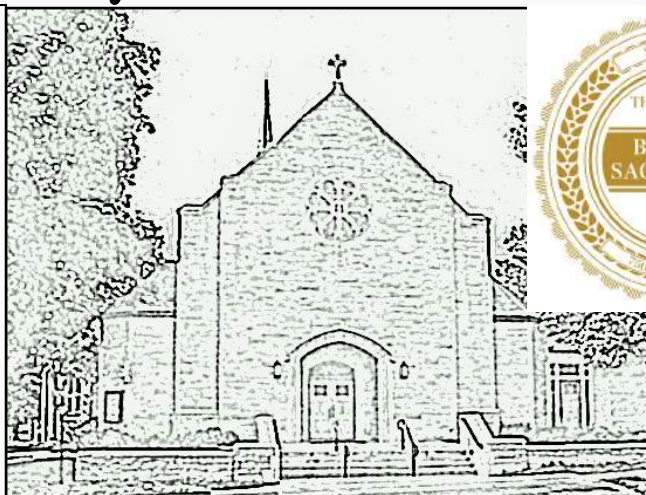

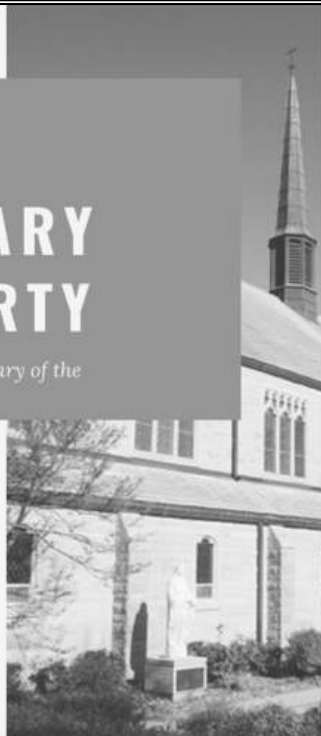

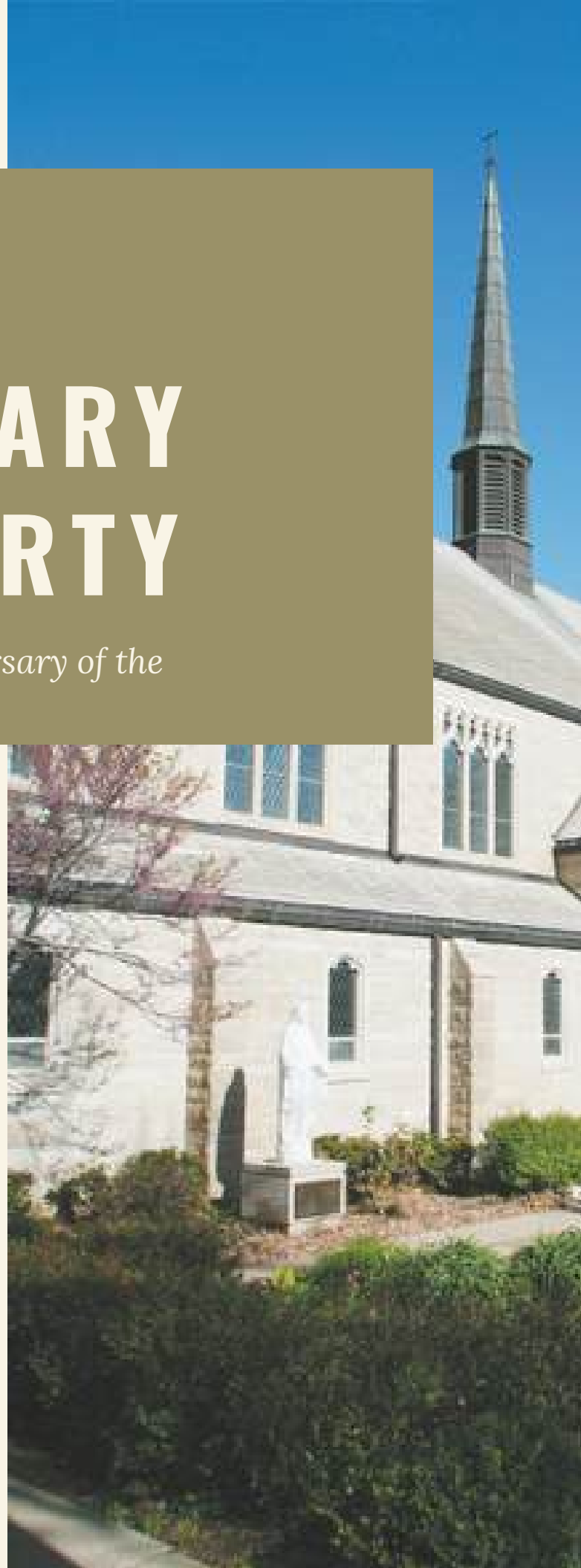

Main Work

Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration is a profound expression of the Catholic Church's love and reverence for the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. In this devotion, someone is always present with our Lord—24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Given our parish bears the name *Blessed Sacrament*, it is especially fitting that we host this ongoing devotion.

Adoration offers a sacred and peaceful opportunity to spend quality time with Jesus in a quiet, intimate setting—a true respite and refuge from the busyness of life. Adorers typically commit to one hour a week. During this time, many choose to pray, read spiritual writings, or simply sit in loving silence with the Lord. At Blessed Sacrament, adoration takes place in the church

during the day and continues in the secured night chapel during evening hours.

On August 5, Blessed Sacrament will celebrate 40 years of Perpetual Adoration. Currently, there are about

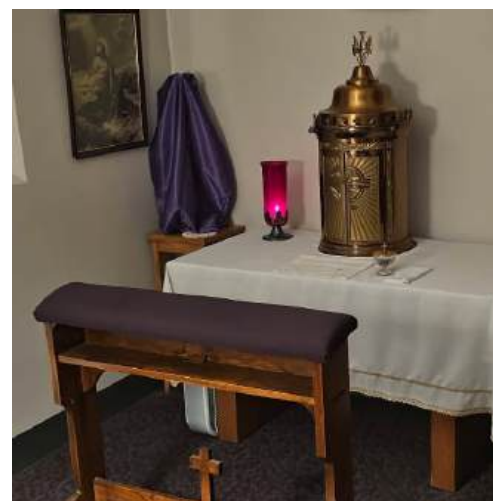
15 original adorers who still have a holy hour, including Lois Korinek who helped start the program in 1985.

For several years, the late Bishop Flavin quietly kept a Friday evening holy hour at Blessed Sacrament. He had been invited to attend just one hour shortly after the program started. The following week, he asked if he could keep that hour going forward, but asked it not be made public, knowing other parishes in the city also offered Perpetual Adoration.

“Perpetual” means continuous—without intermission or interruption. To keep our adoration program truly perpetual, committed adorers are needed to fill the open hours Blessed Sacrament currently has. While some are during the night, many adorers find these quiet moments to be the most spiritually enriching.

Adorers can choose to take an hour weekly, every other week, or even once a month. If someone is not able to commit to a regular hour, there are other opportunities to serve the program as a substitute adorers or on the committee responsible for keeping the adoration schedule.

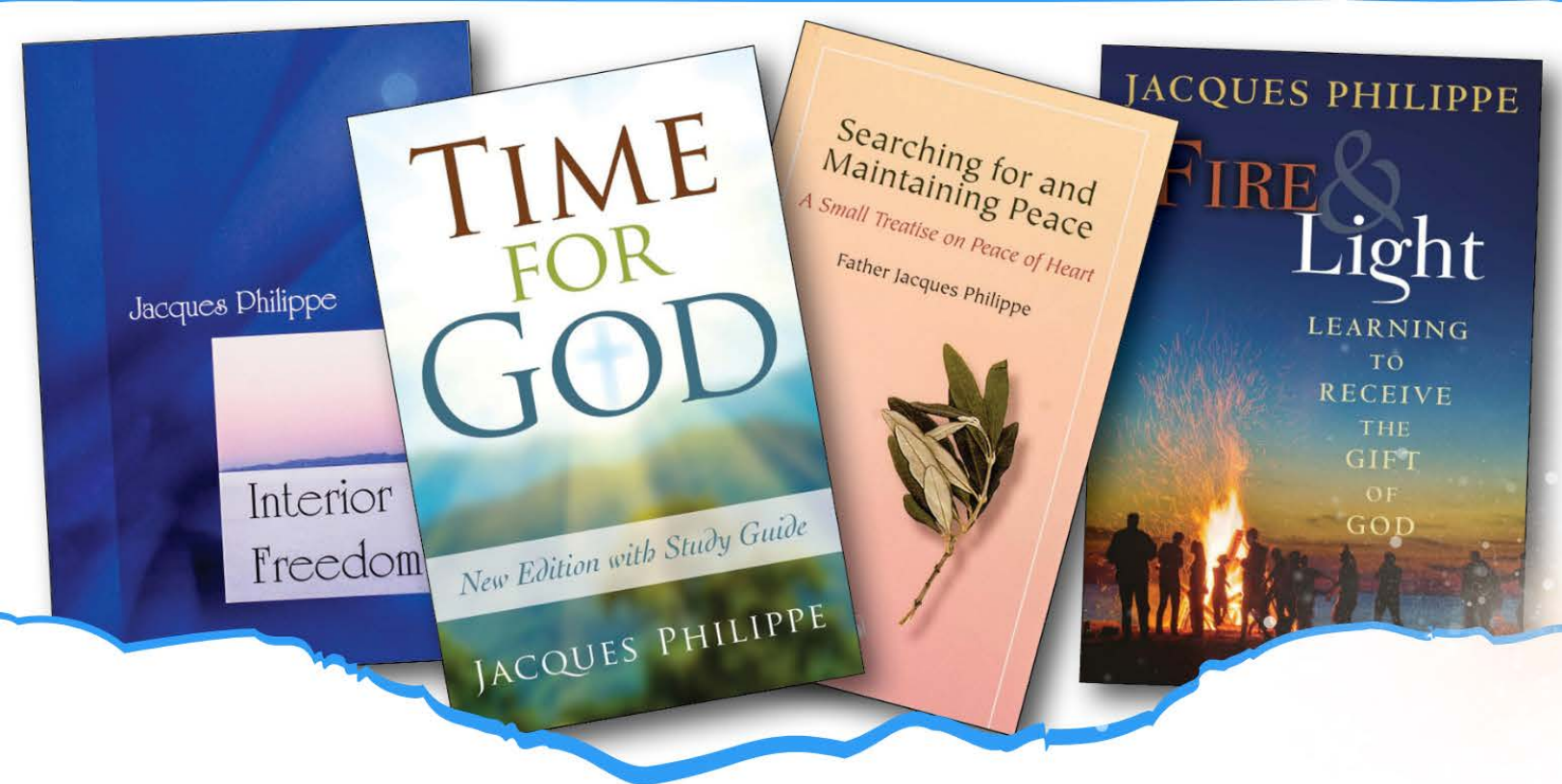
