  - Bids were solicited for outdoor lighting of the parking lot and school, but there was only one response that was twice the budget. Looking for ways to improve contractors' interest in offering a bid.
  - An engineering firm will be asked to look at the roof over the boiling room, which is the courtyard between the old and new school buildings. The interior portion of the roof has exposed rebar and other elements necessitating inspection.
- School Jennifer Tran Reporting
  - Enrollment update: Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade will be approximately 138 students, up from 127 in the 2025 school year.
  - A new school logo is being designed, and samples were handed out; the reception of the council was very favorable.
  - o A new school secretary has been hired.
  - o Looking for a half-time counselor or student service coordinator.
  - o Looking for a long-term substitute teacher to fill in during expected maternity leave.
  - A new recruitment method will be implemented to send a package to new Church baptisms to welcome a new Comet student to the Parish.
  - Summer building updates are in progress with cabinetry and carpet being installed in rooms to update the aesthetic.
  - o The PTO President is leaving, and a replacement is being sought.
- Altar Society Katie Kudron Reporting
  - The Altar Society is raising funds to purchase a new monstrance that will be able to display a larger host that will hopefully be visible from further back in the Church. The current monstrance is currently being refinished.
  - o There will be an adult women's retreat on July 19<sup>th</sup>.
  - Members are looking for a new Vice President.

# • Knights of Columbus - Jason Danner Reporting

- o June 3<sup>rd</sup> is litter picked up S. Coddington Rd. Meet at Lee's Chicken at 6:30 PM.
- June 4<sup>th</sup> is the annual planning meeting for the Knights.
- o June 11th is the general meeting.
- The Knights will be handing out Hy-Vee bags that can be filled and turned in; anything collected will go to Catholic Social Services.
- The Knights will work three Saltdogs games in the concession stands to raise money to support Parish programs.

# • Finance Council - Fr. Morin Reporting

- The Pius X Capital Campaign responsibility for Blessed Sacrament will be approximately \$575,000. The finance council has petitioned the Diocese to allow Blessed Sacrament to run its own campaign to fund the Pius X campaign as well as a Parish campaign at the same time. The Parish campaign would begin with a feasibility study.
- o The rental property at 2336 S. 17<sup>th</sup> St. is under contract to be sold for fair market value.
- The Parish and School budgets proposed by the Finance Council were unanimously approved. Proposed – Aldrich, Seconded – Pella.

# <u>Liturgy – Fr. Morin Reporting</u>

- The council continues to search for an opportunity to tithe to a less fortunate Parish or group of Catholics. The Hope of the Poor Mission continues to be a focus with a Missionary trip to Mexico City under consideration.
- The summer Mass schedule was discussed as it becomes more and more difficult to find priests able to sub when one of our priests is away. If it becomes more difficult, a request could be made to scale down Mass offerings during the summer (non-school) months.
- There was a planned 40 Hour Devotion scheduled during Corpus Christi, the Blessed Sacrament feast day on the occasion of our 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary, however, a scheduling conflict beyond our control has rendered that not possible at this time. A new time will be considered in the future.

### Other Discussion Items

- The school gym rental policy was updated to remove the \$100 key deposit, add a \$200 general use deposit and add a provision where the deposit would be forfeited if the fire alarm was pulled during an event. Proposed – Aldrich, Seconded – Ramaekers. Motion passed. The policy will be revisited in a year.
- Fr. Morin presented many volunteer positions within the Church that need to be filled. Many of the
  Parishioners leading various groups are unable to continue, are retiring, or moving out of the Parish.
  If you are interested in getting involved, there are many opportunities; please contact the Parish
  Office or Fr. Morin.
- A final thank you and round of applause was offered for the service of Jennifer Tran as principal. She will be missed in her role, but still in the Parish!
- The next parish council meeting will be Wednesday, July 23<sup>rd,</sup> at 6:00 PM.
- The meeting adjourned around 7:48 PM followed by a closing prayer led by Fr. Morin.
