

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

July 2025

Main Work

In Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS), we figuratively feed the hungry and give drink to the thirsty. All of us long to know the love of the Good Shepherd, but we can get caught up in the "rules" of faith. CGS meets that deeper spiritual hunger through hands-on, Montessori-based learning that helps children develop a personal relationship with Jesus, His Church, and the Sacraments.

Founded in Rome in 1954 by Sofia Cavalletti and Gianna Gobbi, CGS serves children ages 3–12. It was part of Blessed Sacrament for many years but paused due to space constraints. In 2018, Stef Rash received CGS training, initially for use in her home. "As my kids grew older, I saw the need not just at home but in our parish and school." That vision brought CGS back to Blessed Sacrament in 2023. It now serves Pre-K through 2nd grade with multiple weekly sessions.

Did You Know?

CGS follows the Church's liturgical calendar, helping children engage with the feasts and colors of the seasons. One highlight? Pentecost! The children eagerly awaited pulling out the red prayer table cloth. 
