AUGUST 5, 2025, AD HOC PARISH MEETING -You may have heard Pius X High School is having a capital campaign. They are hoping to raise \$23 million to expand their chapel, build a functional fine arts performance auditorium, update locker rooms, and other items. Since Pius X is our parish high school, we here at Blessed Sacrament will naturally be involved in the campaign.

The leadership phase of the campaign has been underway for a few months now, and they are having great success. The parish phase of the campaign begins in August. More information about that will be coming later.

After consulting with our parish Finance Council and the Building & Grounds Committee, we have determined the Pius campaign is an opportunity to address a few needs we have here at the parish, mostly concerning the interior of our church. Things like: updating the sound system; the carpet and paint; possibly doing something about the pews; lighting; & even addressing the sanctuary.

Of course, for a project like this to succeed we need real feedback from you, the parishioner. That is why we have hired the Steier Group to perform a feasibility study. This is the same company that performed the feasibility study and ran the 2021 Community of Hope campaign for us. It looks like they will begin in September, which will put us a little behind the Pius X schedule, but not by much.

Part of the reason for waiting until September to begin the feasibility study is that we need to have an idea of how the proposed changes might look before we can say we like them or not. That is why we have hired the architectural firm of Clark and Associates. And this is where you can play a special role, if you have an interest.

At **6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 5th**, there will be an ad hoc meeting, which will be made up of any parishioner who wants to provide input into the design put together by Clark and Associates and our Building & Grounds Committee. This will be your chance to be actively engaged in the updating of our church interior, but it won't be your only chance. Depending upon how that meeting goes, we might have another ad hoc meeting. Following that, Clark and Associates will be here for a weekend of Masses to show everyone the results of all this work. After that weekend, the Steier Group will begin their feasibility study to determine more precisely the level of support the parishioners have for these possible changes.

If you are interested and able to attend, I look forward to seeing you on the evening of August 5th at the school. In the meantime, I ask everyone's prayers for this project, that our efforts to update this sacred space be pleasing to the Lord and become a real opportunity for us to grow in our sense of the presence of God, who dwells with us.






