There is a \$30 application fee when submitting the online application. **Each family is asked to pay half of this cost or \$15.00, which can be paid by credit or debit card. Pius X will cover the remaining \$15.00 fee. The majority of the scholarships are based on financial need.**

Parent(s) or guardian(s) wanting to be considered for tuition assistance based on financial need must complete the FACTS Grant & Aid assessment section of the online application. They will need their 2017 Income Tax Return to complete the application. All info provided is kept confidential. Upon completion, parents/guardians will mail or fax the supporting documentation to FACTS. The tax info needed to verify the application will be shown in the FGAA Checklist that is found online. If someone is only applying for non-financial need scholarships, this portion of the application does not need to be filled out.
