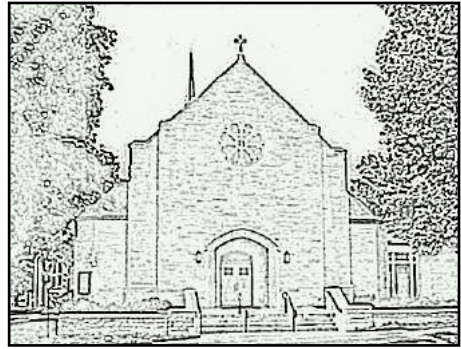

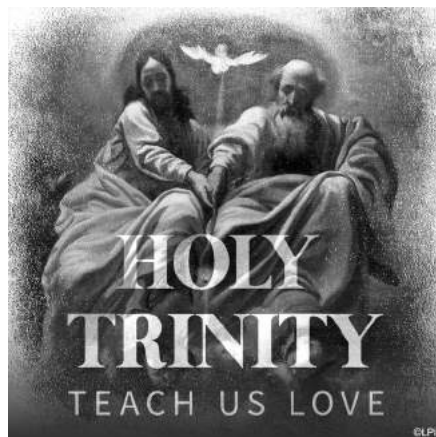

The Lincoln Council Society of St. Vincent de Paul, Blessed Sacrament Conference was aggregated in 1998 and is celebrating 35 years of service.

Their vocation is to follow Christ through service to those in need and so bear witness to His compassionate and liberating love. They serve in hope and show their commitment through person-to-person contact.

Every person/family situation is unique, so the time spent with each varies. In 2022, they averaged 17.6 hours of dedicated time per month which included time for home visits, travel time, purchases for needs, paying bills, paperwork, and two or three monthly meetings.

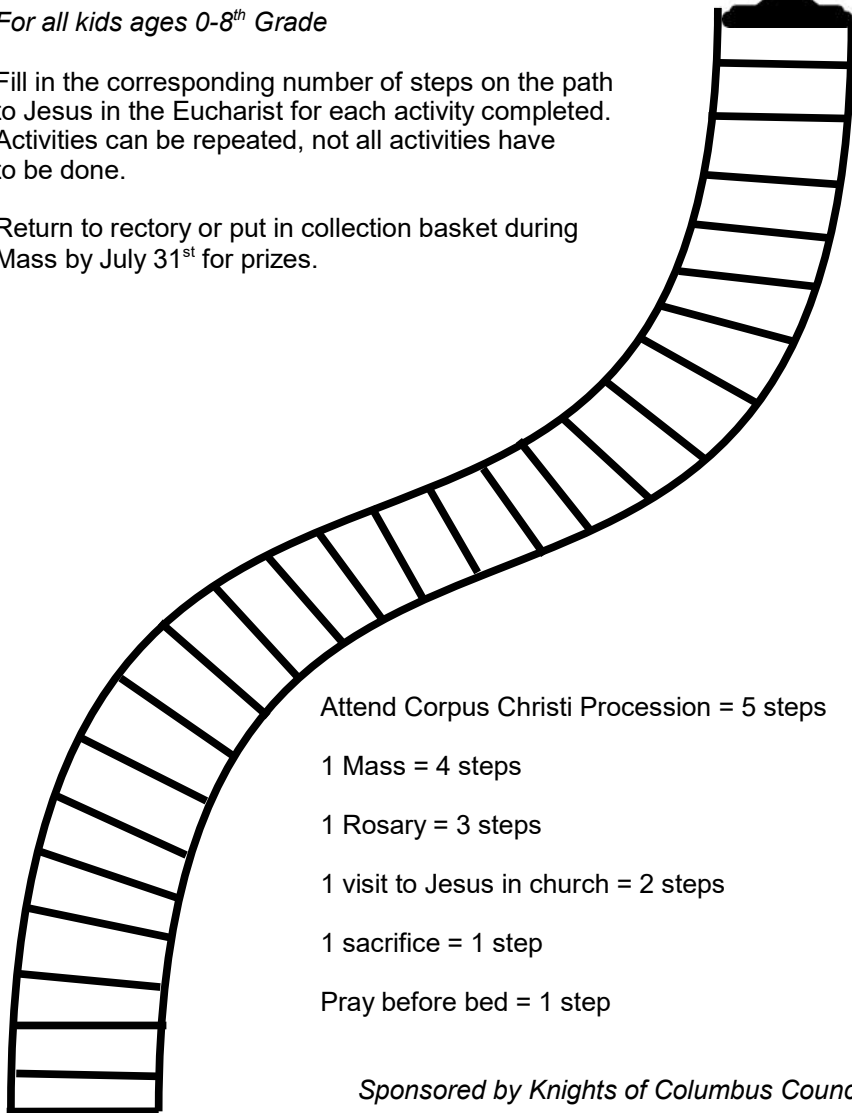

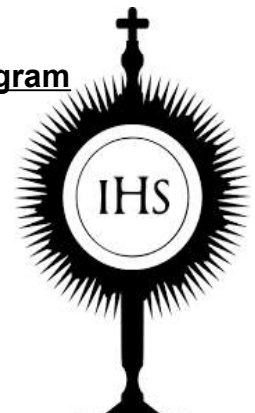

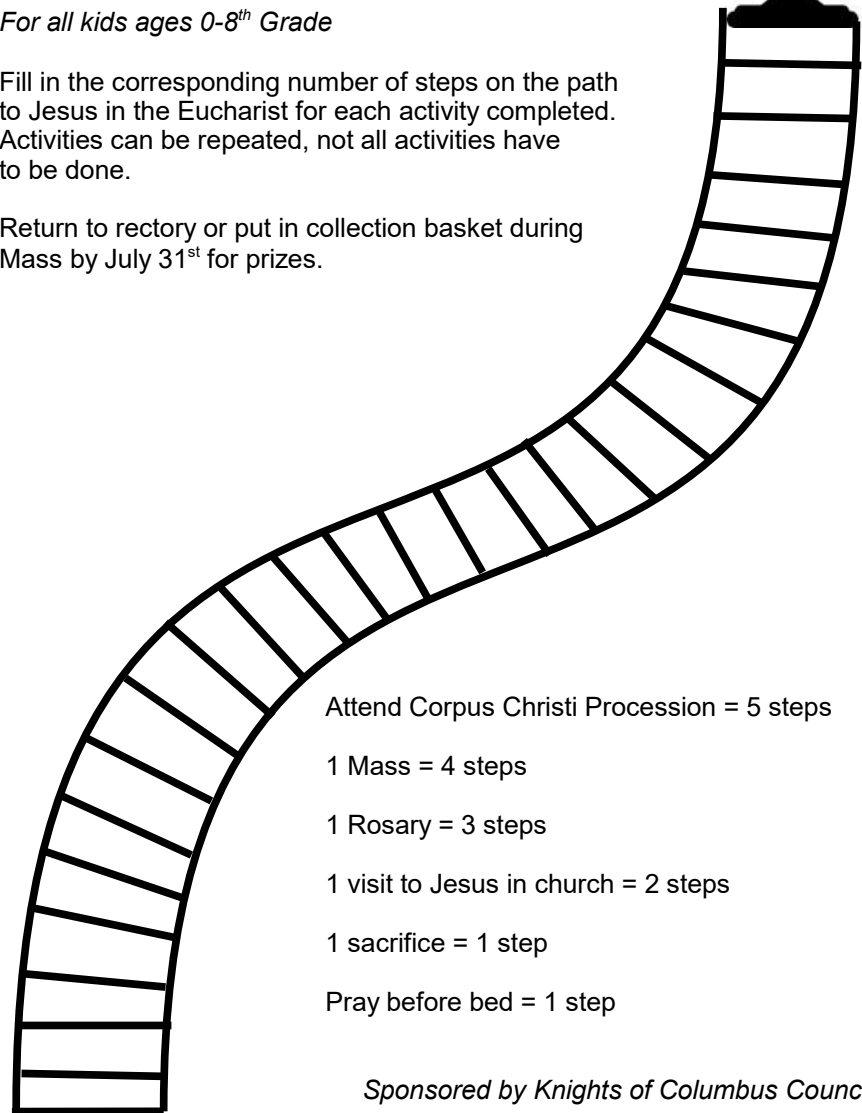
