



## COMMUNITY OF HOPE CAMPAIGN

As we get closer to kicking off the **BLESSED SACRAMENT: A COMMUNITY OF HOPE** campaign, we recently mailed an expanded list of FAQs to parish families & each week will try to inform you more about our plans. This weekend we look at the campaign timeline & giving information:

**When will the campaign begin & who will be asked to make a pledge or gift?** We will hold a formal kickoff for June 19<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup> & the campaign will run through August. Each registered parish family will receive a letter from Father Morin inviting them to consider a specific request to the campaign. We must understand this is not the financial responsibility of a few families. In the spirit of good stewardship, all of us are asked to make sacrificial & meaningful donations to ensure a successful future for our parish. We also are hopeful that parishioners will consider a three-year pledge to maximize their contributions.

**How do I make my pledge?** Each family will either receive a pledge card via the parish mailing or through a meeting with a campaign volunteer. Completed pledge cards will either be left with the volunteer or can be returned via the mail or to the parish office.

**What different ways can I give?** In addition to pledges or one-time gifts, pledge cards also will give parishioners an option to contribute by stock, life insurance, property, or estate planning.

**How will the *Community of Hope* campaign affect parish offertory?** Through the effort, Blessed Sacrament will ask parishioners to make pledges beyond their regular giving. We will not ask parishioners to diminish their offertory support, but to consider a commitment above their normal tithe. In the long term, similar campaigns have led to increases in weekly giving by raising the sights of parishioners and their commitment to the church.


