**A NOTE FROM OUR MUSIC DIRECTOR** - We are a singing people – our faith is strengthened by our community song & we long to raise our voices together in prayer & praise. So, now that the church is open again, why aren't we singing? In the current health crisis, we are protecting our community from the virus as best we can. When we sing, the vibration of our vocal folds chops up the breath from our lungs into miniscule, invisible, virtually weightless particles. This process is called “aerosolization,” & the aerosol cloud created by the act of sustained group singing can persist in the environment of a room for hours. People singing (& breathing) together share each other's cloud. A single voice creates a much smaller, less dense cloud. Experts suggest that one singer at a distance (a cantor in the loft) poses a minimal

risk while giving voice to the sung prayer of the entire assembly. We are called to care for others, & for the time being, we answer that call with the song in our hearts. The day will come when we are able to sing together; for now, we continue to pray for patience & grace.
