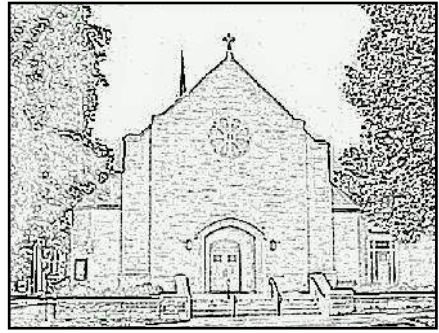

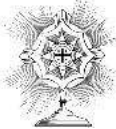

### **DATES & EVENTS:**

**MISSION COOPERATIVE APPEAL** - We welcome Fr. Thomas Kagumisa to our parish this weekend for our annual Mission appeal. Fr. Thomas is a priest of the

diocese of Bukoba, one of the 34 dioceses found in Tanzania, East Africa. It is located in the northeastern part of the country, on the shores of Lake Victoria. The diocese has a population of about 1.1 million & out of these, 58% are Catholics. The diocese is made up of 40 parishes & more than 300 mission stations. Almost all the parishes & mission stations are in underdeveloped areas. Small-scale farming is the main occupation of these poor & needy people.

Meeting the expenses of running the diocese with its institutions is a big challenge to the diocesan authorities. Because of this, the diocesan Bishop of Bukoba requested participation in the 2023 Missionary Appeal Plan in some of the Diocese in America, one of them being the Diocese of Lincoln, NE. Apart from sharing missionary experiences in the mission lands with American dioceses through this program, the bishop requests donations to support pastoral & social activities in the diocese. The Diocese of Bukoba struggles to train enough priests to meet the demands. As for the program of priestly formation in Tanzania, seminarians start with three years of prerequisite classes in Philosophy, then four years of systematic Theology, & one year of pastoral experience. Total eight years in major seminaries. The annual cost for seminary formation is \$2,500.00 per seminarian. Of this amount, \$500.00 is covered by subsidies from Rome. The diocese is asked to pay the remaining amount. Your support at next weekend's second collection for the Mission Appeal can make a huge difference for Bukoba & other missionary parts of the Church throughout the world.

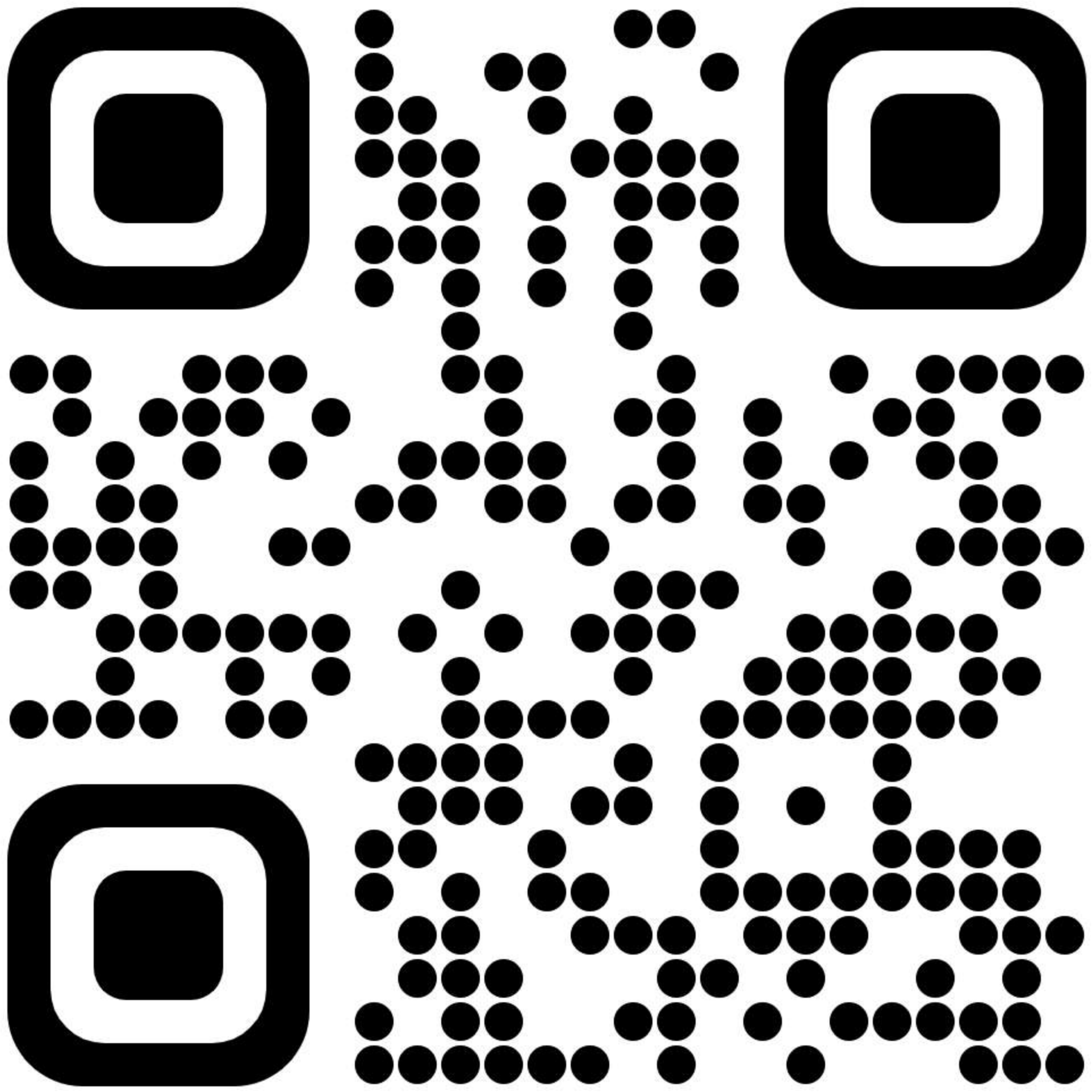
