CCD REGISTRATION - OPEN

CCD Fall Registration is here! Parish tuition rates for CCD Registration are \$40 per child, or \$100 per family. Additionally, parents registering children for CCD will be asked to pay a Diocesan Religious Education Fee of \$15 dollars per student, in addition to the Parish tuition fees. The Diocesan Religious Education Fee is being assessed to provide funding to support the administrative services, resources, and materials provided by the Diocesan Religious Education Office.
