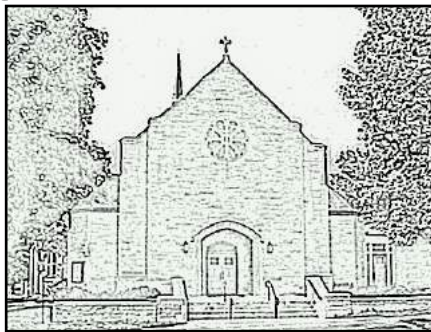

## PARISH NEWS

### DATES & EVENTS:

**AUGUST 12-13, 2023, CCD FALL REGISTRATION**-is here, & we invite parents to plan to take advantage of the Early Bird Registration weekend event scheduled Aug. 12<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup>. Registrations for **CCD** will be taken after the Sat. evening Mass, Aug. 12<sup>th</sup>, & before & after the Sun. Masses Aug. 13<sup>th</sup>.

During the CCD Early Bird Registration weekend, Parish tuition rates will be \$35.00 for an individual child, \$70.00 for two children or a family rate of \$90.00. These tuition rates will only be available during the CCD Early Bird Registration weekend. We will also honor these rates for registration turned in during the week of Aug. 7<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>. Parish tuition

rates after the CCD Early Bird Registration weekends are \$40.00 / child, or \$100.00 / family.

**Additionally**, parents registering children for CCD will be asked to pay a **Diocesan Religious Education Fee of \$15.00, per student**, in addition to the Parish tuition fees. The DRE Fee is being assessed to provide funding to support the administrative services, resources, & materials provided by the DRE Office.

Completed registration forms with tuition fees can be turned in at the registration table during the registration weekends or dropped in the collection basket at any of the Masses or they can be mailed or dropped off directly to the rectory at: 1720 Lake St., Lincoln, NE 68502. **Please indicate "CCD" on the envelope. Please make checks payable to Blessed Sacrament Church.**

CCD tuition & DRE fees can be paid using the parish Online Giving application. The link to the application is <https://giving.parishsoft.com/App/Giving/bse>. Once you've logged on to your account, use the **CCD Tuition** Fund option for exact CCD tuition fees due & the **DRE Fee** Fund option for exact Diocesan Education fees due.

**Please note: If you choose to use the Online Giving application as your method of payment, we ask that exact fees due be paid for each Fund & not as installments over a period of time. Additionally, a completed registration form must be turned in at the rectory for processing purposes & routing to the CCD Coordinator.**

**Copies of Baptismal certificates will be required at the time of registration for students being enrolled in grades 1, 2 & 5 in the CCD program.** All students are required to provide a copy of their baptismal certificate upon initial enrollment with the CCD program. If you have not provided a copy of your student's baptismal certificate within the past two years, we ask that one be submitted along with your registration this year.

### IMPACT IN OUR PARISH AND COMMUNITY

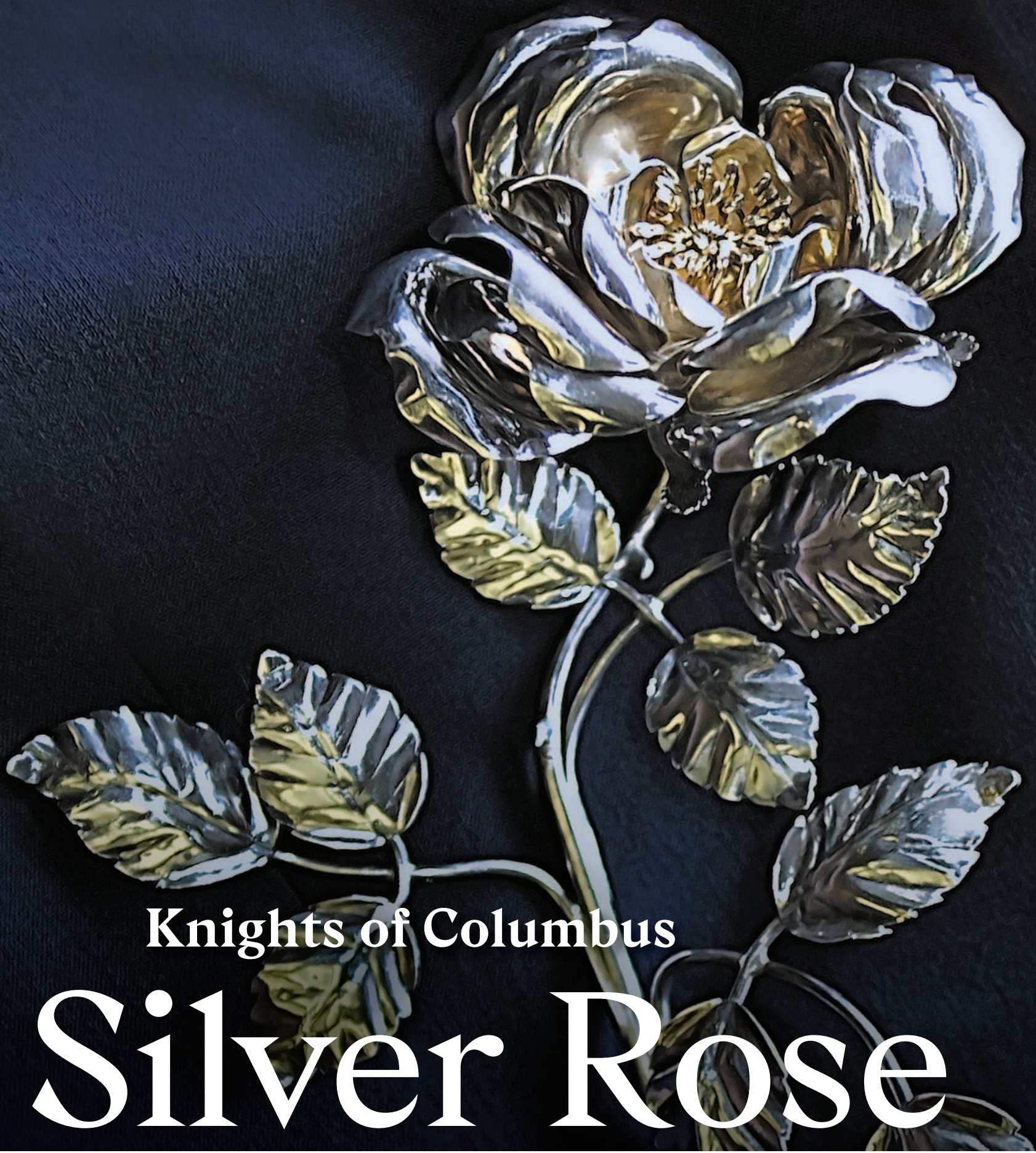
