ATTENTION – SANITIZATION OF CHURCH PEWS - When attending any of our scheduled Masses at the parish, please leave the kneeler in the DOWN position

before you leave. By doing this, volunteers will know which pews need to be sanitized. Kneelers in the DOWN position prior to a Mass will indicate the pew has not been sanitized. You can either sanitize the pew before occupying it or sit in another pew where the kneeler is in the UP position. Sanitizing wipes are located on the counter in the bride's room. Also, feel free to sanitize the pew you were sitting in after Mass but be sure to place the kneeler in the UP

BLESSED SACRAMENT PRE-KINDERGARTEN CLASS ENROLLMENT IS FULL NOW - Thank you to all the families that have signed their children up.

AUGUST 17, 2020, 1ST DAY OF THE 2020-21 SCHOOL YEAR - The 1st day of school for PK-8th grade is Mon., Aug. 17th. Our dismissal is 12 p.m. on Aug. 17th. No Hot Lunch or Extended Care on the 1st day, please plan accordingly.

BEFORE SCHOOL BEGINS:

- * Buy a mask for your Kindergarten -8th grader to wear on the first day of school.
- * Complete the Covid-19 Screening Form. This was emailed to families by Mrs. Tvrdy & can be found here <https://blessed-sacrament-school.com/wp-content/uploads/2020/07/Covid-parent-signature-form.docx>. Students may not attend school without this form completed.
- * Complete & submit any necessary school forms as mentioned in the Wed. Weekly

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL:

- * Wear your mask.
- * Pre-K – 5th grades will enter through the Main Entrance. 6th – 8th grades will enter through the NW Door (Extended Care Door).
- * Be prepared to say good-bye to your student at the door. Parents are not permitted to walk their child to their classroom.
- * Bring your supplies! Staff will be available to help younger students carry their supplies.

AUGUST 19, 2020, CCD CLASSES - begin Wednesday evening. Please come a little early to pick up a schedule. Beginning Prayer & Blessing starts at 6:30 p.m. in the School Gym followed by some opening remarks from Fr. Morin & introductions of the CCD Program staff.

CCD REGISTRATION - Many thanks to all the parents who took advantage of the CCD Early Bird Registration weekends & registering their children early for CCD classes. If you have not registered your children for CCD it's NOT TOO LATE. In fact, we encourage all families with children who will be attending CCD this year to turn in their registrations before the first night of classes. This will allow the coordinators an opportunity to prepare class rosters & ensure the instructors have all the necessary materials ready for the first night. Registrations forms are available on the Parish website or contact the rectory to obtain a copy. Tuition rates are \$40.00 per child, or \$100.00 per family and tuition assistance is available. Additionally, parents registering children for CCD will be asked to pay a Diocesan Religious Education Fee of \$15.00 dollars, per student, in addition to the Parish tuition. The Diocesan Religious Education Fee is being assessed to provide funding to support the administrative services, resources, & materials provided by the Diocesan Religious Education Office.

Completed registrations can be dropped off at the rectory during normal business hours, placed in the offering baskets during any Mass or they can be mailed to the rectory. Please mark "CCD Registration" on the envelope when sending registrations by mail or if placed in the offering basket. Additionally, CCD tuition & Diocesan Religious Education fees can be made using the parish Online Giving application. The link to the application is <https://giving.parishsoft.com/App/Giving/bsc>. Please do not send registrations to Blessed Sacrament School.

Copies of Baptismal certificates will be required at the time of registration for students being enrolled in grades 1, 2 & 5 in the CCD program. All students are required to provide a copy of their baptismal certificate upon initial enrollment with the CCD program. If you have not provided a copy of your student's baptismal certificate within the past two years, we ask that one be submitted along with your registration this year.
