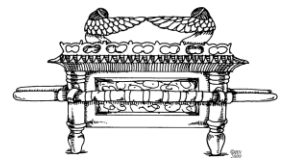




COR JESU REX

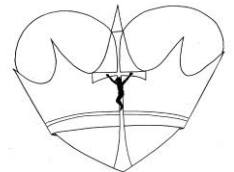
