Main Work

The role of the Stewardship Committee at Blessed Sacrament is to share the many opportunities available to our parishioners to not just get involved, but to grow in their faith. We do this through a monthly bulletin insert (like this one!) and the annual stewardship fair which was held last month.

Our Place of Hope & Promise, our monthly newsletter, highlights one of the many groups we have for parishioners to get involved and the positive impact that group has in our parish. We send a short list of questions to the group to be featured and then draft the newsletter based on their responses. Once the newsletter is approved, it is sent to the rectory to include in the bulletin.

The Blessed Sacrament Stewardship Fair takes place each fall in the school gym. Our committee is responsible for contacting the leaders of each group, notifying them of the days/time of the

event and compiling a list of groups participating. The weekend of the event, we set up the tables, organize a raffle and be on-site to assist all participants.

Did You Know?

At our recent stewardship fair, we had 24 groups participate. Many had several people sign up to join or request more information. Everyone who walked in the gym was given an entry form for a chance to win a \$100 gift card. The form asked “What group/organization impressed you the most and why?” It provided the committee with great feedback like:

- Prayer Chain: “I didn’t know Blessed Sacrament had this. Intercessory prayers is beautiful.”
- Pro-Life: “I didn’t realize how many different activities their group does to support the pro-life cause.”
- Perpetual Adoration: “Gives me the opportunity to drop everything and pray.”
- Welcome Committee: “Friendly volunteer. Display of welcome basket. Desire to welcome others to Blessed Sacrament.”



- Meals for Priests: “The importance of healthy meals for our priests.”
